Option #4

Creation Pudding

Supplies needed: chocolate and vanilla pudding (Prepackaged or made ahead of time), gummy bears, m&m's, cool whip, blue jello gelatin powder, crushed oreos, sprinkles shaped like flowers, yellow sprinkles to represent the sun moon and stars (you can find all of this in cake baking aisle) gummy worms, teddy grahams and chocolate syrup.

9 x 11 inch ((or bigger) see through pan.

Small paper cups, plastic spoons, napkins and wet wipes for cleanup.

Tell the creation story, but pause after each day... adding the ingredient that fits that day. You can have one leader telling the story while the other makes the pudding in front of the group.

> Day 1 Layer of Vanilla pudding and a layer of chocolate pudding (light and dark)

> > Day 2 Cool Whip (sky) Sprinkle lightly with blue jello powder (water)

Day 3 Crushed Oreo cookies (ground) flower shaped sprinkles or cake decorations (plants and trees)

> Day 4 Yellow cake sprinkles (sun, moon, stars)

> > Day 5

M&M's (fish) (Substitute sweet fish or bird shaped item)

Day 6

Teddy grams or gummy bears (animals) Chocolate Syrup (draw the shape of a man and a woman on the top of the pudding)

While serving it to the children, have someone read Jeremiah 29:11 and John 10:10
